

It was Father Nicolas Barre's experience of God's magnanimous and abundant love for him and the people that inspired him to respond to God's call to be the instrument in founding the Infant Jesus Sisters. As he grew closer to God, he became more aware of the plight of the poor and decided to act in providing education for children and young people especially girls. He felt strongly that a holistic education was the way to lift them from poverty and give them self-esteem, dignity and meaning in life.

His love for God influenced his way of thinking and acting. Although he experienced misunderstanding, rejection and difficulties in his life and work, he was so secure in God's unconditional love for him that he was able to surmount all the challenges to fulfil his mission and purpose in life. He had great courage and fulfilled his deepest aspiration to want all children and persons to know that God loves each person and that He sent His only son, Jesus, to show us the way of salvation.
